

Home Health Downloadable Archive Files – Comma Separated Value Files

The files included in each downloadable archive file include the following:

Quality Measures	Columns indicating the HHA's risk-adjusted value (percentage) for each quality measure. The number of columns changes over time as measures are added to or dropped from Home Health Compare. The column heading indicates the specific measure name as it appears on Home Health Compare. Within the data rows, a value of 199 indicates the HHA did not have enough patients to whom the measure applied. A value of 201 indicates that no measures were calculated for the HHA because of insufficient data or because the HHA had less than 6 months of data (usually because the HHA had been in operation as a Medicare-certified HHA for less than 6 months at the end of the data collection period). Values less than 5% are reported as 5, and values greater than 95 are reported as 95.
